Tuition, Fees and Books (<i>academic year</i>) <i>(This is based on the legal requirement that you must be a full-time student with 12 credits in the spring and fall semesters.)</i>	\$14,750
Health and Medical Insurance (<i>academic year</i>) <i>(All international students are required to participate in a comprehensive health insurance plan. It is a basic policy that covers you if you are sick or if you need emergency medical care. If you have health insurance from another source, you can waive this fee by showing proof.)</i>	\$1,197 <i>(if under 24)</i> \$2,403 <i>(if over 24)</i>
Monthly Rent (<i>\$700x9</i>)	\$6,300
Monthly Utilities (<i>\$150x9</i>) <i>Includes heat, electricity and phone. Heating costs in winter may be higher).</i>	\$1,350
Food Allowance (<i>\$300x9</i>)	\$2,700
Transportation (<i>\$60x9</i>) <i>(For monthly bus pass or gas for cars. MCC parking is free.)</i>	\$540
Recreation (<i>100x9</i>) <i>(movies, cable television, dining out, etc.)</i>	\$900
